GENERAL RULES FOR THIS SHOW

1. The show is based on CEF Rules.
 2. The Judges decision is final. Any harassment of the Judge will disqualify the exhibitor. Please approach the committee if there are questions.
 3. For this show, ages as follows
Age as of January 1, 2010
Junior A 13 to 18 yrs
Junior B 9 to 12 yrs
Junior C 8 yrs and under
Senior 19 and over
Jack Benny 39 and over
 4. A separate entry form will be required for each horse.
 5. The show committee reserves the right to decide at any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make alterations if necessary to rules, prizes or program.
 6. The Horse Show Committee will have the right to cancel or combine classes at its discretion. If less than 3 riders in the Junior Classes, they may be combined.
 7. CSA approved helmets are mandatory in all jumping classes.
 8. Emphasis will be on safety. All riders who have not reached their 19th Birthday as of January 1, 2010, are recommended to wear a CSA approved riding helmet. Safety of tack, equipment, riding apparel, footwear will be stressed. Riders to have shoes/boots with hard soles and heels. Clothing to be clean and tidy, to consist of long sleeves (Shirt, Jacket or sweater), long pants (jeans, stretch pants), safe footwear (shoe/boot with a heel that cannot slip through the stirrup).
 9. The DC Horse Club and the horse show committee will not be responsible for damage, injury or loss or theft of any horse or injury to any exhibitor.
 10. No stallion may be handled by a Junior exhibitor for any class.
 11. Competitors may only enter three consecutive jumping heights (excluding Stake Class).
 12. Novice Rider/ Walt Trot cannot cross enter in any other riding classes except Jack Benny Classes. Novice Horse /Walt Trot cannot cross enter in any other riding classes.
 13. Lead Line Handlers must be 18 years or older.
 14. Horses must be under control at all times, and at the judges discretion the competitor may be excused from the arena.
